



## UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT WESTERN DISTRICT OF TENNESSEE

The Omnibus Appropriations Act of 2009, signed in to law by the President on March 11, 2009, authorized and provided funds to raise the non-capital hourly panel attorney compensation rate from \$100 to \$110, and the maximum hourly capital rate from \$170 to \$175 (for federal capital prosecutions and capital post-conviction proceedings). These rates apply to attorneys appointed to represent eligible persons under the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, and the Antiterrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act of 1996, codified in part in 18 U.S.C. § 3599.

The new hourly compensation rates apply to work performed on or after March 11, 2009. Where the appointment of counsel occurred before this effective date, the new compensation rates apply to that portion of services provided on or after March 11, 2009.

Effective February 1, 2009, the mileage rate for the use of privately owned vehicles while on official business is 55 cents per mile.
