ORDER

This is a *pro se* lawsuit brought against the remaining Defendants Tasma Doaks and Felicia Jones, and is before this Magistrate Judge on referral regarding their Motion to Compel [D.E. 16]. The case is currently stayed pending resolution of this issue [D.E. 21].

As relevant background, Defendants served discovery on Plaintiff June 11, 2014 and have received no response. This discovery consisted of interrogatories, requests for production of documents and requests for admissions. Having received no responses to the discovery, counsel for Defendants communicated by mail that if no responses were made by Plaintiff by the date of August 4, 2014, Defendants would file a motion to compel - which was done by Defendants on August 6, 2014. Nor has there been any subsequent response by Plaintiff to the discovery efforts of Defendants.

Based upon the above, the Court determines that Defendants' Motion to Compel should be GRANTED and ORDERS the Plaintiff to respond to the interrogatories, requests for production of documents and requests for admissions previously served on Plaintiff. His responses shall be post-marked no later than January 15, 2015.

Plaintiff is notified that in the event he does not comply with this Order of the Court, this lawsuit may be dismissed and Defendants may be awarded expenses, attorneys' fees and court costs.
