

At this time, there are only three pending motions (excluding suppression motions which will be addressed by a separate order) to which the government has responded and to which Lazar should be allowed an opportunity to file a reply brief. These motions are: (1) Defendant's Omnibus Discovery Motion, Docket #72; (2) Defendant's Motion for a Hearing Pursuant to *Franks v. Delaware* as to Two Search Warrant Affidavits, Dated October 9, 2002, Docket # 77; and (3) Defendant's Motion to Dismiss Indictment Based on Unconstitutional General Instructions to the Grand Jury and for Leave to File, Docket # 89.

For good cause shown, Lazar's motion is granted as to these three motions. Lazar may file with the court and serve on the government replies to these three motions on or before Monday, November 15, 2004, at 5:00 p.m.
