ORDER GRANTING GOVERNMENT'S MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO RESPOND
TO TWO OF DEFENDANT'S MOTIONS
AND MOTION TO STRIKE (Doc. No. 146)

Before the court is the government's October 27, 2004 motion for additional time to respond to two of defendant's motions and, in the alternative, to strike defendant's two motions. The motion was referred to the United States Magistrate Judge for determination.

The government's motion for additional time to respond to the defendant's motion to dismiss for Failure to State a Crime (Doc. No. 82) is granted. The government shall file its response eleven days after the defendant serves copies of the referenced articles on the government.

The government's motion for additional time to respond to the defendant's *Brady* motion for immediate disclosure of exculpatory evidence (Doc. No. 75) is granted. The government shall file its

response within eleven days after receiving a supplemental redacted version of Exhibit B to the defendant's *Brady* motion as ordered by the court this date in a separately filed order.

The government's motion to strike is denied.
