In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. § 631 et seq., and the authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is



The said United States Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties on the 21st day of November 2003.



IT IS SO ORDERED.




