REVISE SPEEDY TRIAL ACT PLAN


On June 18, 1980, this court, pursuant to the Speedy Trial Act of 1974, adopted a Plan for the Speedy Disposition of Criminal Cases in the Western District of Tennessee. Because of subsequent amendments to the Speedy Trial Act of 1974, the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, and the Local Rules of this Court, the Plan for the Speedy Disposition of Criminal Cases in the Western District of Tennessee is in need of review and revision. Therefore, the judges of this court have appointed a committee to review the court's Speedy Trial Plan and to make suggestions concerning revision of the Plan.
