At its meeting of March 22, 2005, this court adopted modifications to its "Amended Plan of the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee Providing Representation for Defendants who are Financially Unable to Obtain an Adequate Defense in Criminal Cases in the Courts of the United States, Adopted in Accordance with 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, as Amended," (CJA Plan). These modifications are to Section 1(A) and 1) increase the maximum number of panel attorneys in the Jackson Division from 15 to 20; 2) require that all applications for appointment to the CJA panels be submitted to the Clerk of Court; and, 3) give the court discretion to increase the number of panel members in either of the district's divisions from time to time as workload necessitates. Therefore, consistent with the court's expression, it is,

ORDERED that Section 1 (A), "CJA Panel of Attorneys," of the CJA Plan be amended in accordance with the stated modifications. The amended Plan shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit. The Clerk of Court shall

thereafter cause notice of this amended CJA Plan to be published for a period of thirty days.
