Robert R. Di Trolio formerly served as the Clerk of Court for this District Court until his separation from service on June 3, 2005.

At the time of his separation the District Court cancelled all of the banking business signature authorities extended to him as the Clerk of Court. This cancellation is set forth in Administrative Order 2005-12 dated May 20, 2005.

Effective May 20, 2005, Deputy Clerk Mary Mangone was authorized in Administrative Order 2005-12 to execute funds on two non-appropriated accounts (the Pro Bono Expense Fund and the Court Improvement Fund) and was extended the banking business signature authorities previously held by Robert R. Di Trolio.


Effective as of the date of this Administrative Order, the banking business signature authorities for this District Court's two non-appropriated accounts (the Pro Bono Expense Fund and the Court Improvement Fund) as well as its Registry Funds are ratified as to Mary Mangone, and she hereby remains authorized to handle these banking transactions for the Court.

Effective on or about June 21, 2005, Thomas M. Gould became the new Clerk of Court for this District Court. In his capacity he was extended the banking business signature authorities of the Clerk of Court and is authorized to transact all banking matters on behalf of the Court,

including but not limited to, the Registry Funds and the two non-appropriated accounts (the Pro Bono Expense Fund and the Court Improvement Fund).

The authorities ratified herein on behalf of Thomas M. Gould and Mary Mangone shall continue as to each until such time as they are cancelled in writing by the Court.
