**ORDER TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE
COURT'S PRO BONO EXPENSE FUND ACCOUNT
TO THE COURT IMPROVEMENT FUND ACCOUNT**

By Administrative Order 93-1, this Court established "The Court Improvement Fund" (the CIF) in recognition of a need to incur certain expenses for the improvement of court operations and for the benefit of the federal bench and bar in the administration of justice. Thereafter, the Court adopted the Plan for the Appointment of Counsel for Pro Se Indigent Parties in Civil Cases and created a trust account called the Pro Bono Expense Fund. The Pro Bono Fund was created as a subsidiary to and funded from deposits previously made into the CIF from attorney admission fees, pro hac vice admission fees and annual enrollment fees. The Clerk of Court was designated as the Custodian of both funds.


The Court is aware of projects that are appropriately funded by the CIF. The balance in the CIF account is available to cover these projects, but the fund would be substantially depleted.

It is therefore

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court, as Custodian of the both funds, effectuate a transfer in the amount of \$75,000.00 from the Pro Bono Expense Fund to the Court Improvement Fund to cover the above-referenced projects and any other expenses the Court may incur for the improvement of court operations and for the benefit of the federal bench and bar in the administration of justice. No other changes in the pertinent plans and no other inter-fund transfers are hereby authorized.
