**ORDER**


Pursuant to the March 26, 2009 Supreme Court approval of changes to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 6 and Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 45 and the Statutory Time Period Technical Amendments Act of 2009, two time frame changes to the Federal Rules of Civil and Criminal Procedure will become effective December 1, 2009.

First, calculation of deadlines less than 11 days will include intermediate weekends and legal holidays in the time period. Second, deadlines less than 30 days will be changed to multiples of seven days so that deadline expiration will occur on a weekday. To mitigate inconsistency with federal rules, deadlines in the local rules of the Western District of Tennessee are hereby amended as follows:

- 5 day deadlines become 7 days;
- 10 and 15 day deadlines become 14 days;
- 20 day deadlines become 21 days; and
- 25 day deadlines become 28 days.

The Clerk of Court shall cause notice of these amendments to be published on the court's web page for a period of thirty days, and thereafter furnish a copy of the Amended Local Rules to the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit.
