
On May 20, 2005 banking business signature authority was given to Deputy Clerk Mary Mangone (authority set forth in Administrative Order No. 2005-12 and confirmed in Administrative Order No. 2008-04). On September 30, 2009 Mary Mangone retired from federal service at which time all banking authorities were cancelled.

The Clerk of Court, Thomas M. Gould, currently has banking business signature authority (effective June 21, 2005 as set forth in Administrative Order No. 2008-04) for this District Court's two non-appropriated accounts (the Court Improvement Fund and the *Pro Bono* Expense Fund Account) as well as its Registry accounts.

Effective as of the date of this Administrative Order, banking business authority for this District Court's external Registry Fund accounts are extended to Deputy Clerk Tracy Wherry. This authority permits Deputy Clerk Wherry to conduct banking business in connection with the Court's external Registry Fund accounts in the event of the unavailability of the Clerk of Court. This authority includes initial investments, renewing of investments and withdrawals upon order of the court. This authority, however, does not include signatory authority with regard to the Court's non-appropriate accounts (the Court Improvement Fund and the *Pro Bono* Expense Fund Account).

The authorities confirmed and ratified herein shall continue until such time as either or both are cancelled in writing by the Court.
