

REFERRING CERTAIN MATTERS TO MAGISTRATE JUDGE  
FOR DETERMINATION

For the period May 19 to May 28, 2010, all discovery matters in both civil and criminal cases, all requests for extension of time to file or respond, requests for leave to reply, all motions to continue, and any non-dispositive motion requiring determination prior to May 28 are hereby referred to the Magistrate Judge to whom the case is assigned for determination in cases assigned to United States District Judge Samuel H. Mays, Jr. If the assigned Magistrate Judge is unavailable, or if no Magistrate Judge has been assigned, the Clerk Shall randomly assign the matter to a Magistrate Judge.
