
IN RE: STANDARD REVIEW POLICY
FOR *JOHNSON* CASES

Administrative Order: 2016-21

By unanimous decision of the Court, the following is established as the standard review procedure for matters filed pursuant to *Johnson v. United States*, 135 S. Ct. 2251 (2015), under 28 U.S.C. §2255 in the Western District of Tennessee.

Without further instruction, each motion filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2255 in the Western District of Tennessee seeking relief under *Johnson v United States* will be reviewed by the United States Probation Office. Upon completion of the review, the Court will be provided a memorandum with the probation officer's assessment. Copies of the assessment shall be provided to all parties and/or their representative. If the Court should vacate a sentence under 28 U.S.C. §2255 based on *Johnson* and set the matter for re-sentencing, the matter will be referred to the United States Probation Office to prepare a Supplemental Presentence Investigation Report.
