
Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1871, as amended, grand and petit jurors providing extended service may receive an increase of the statutory attendance fee of \$40 per day up to \$10 for each day in excess of 45 days for grand jurors and 10 days for petit jurors at the discretion of the district judge in charge of the particular jury. The District Judges of the Western District of Tennessee have agreed that an increase in juror fees for extended service, as provided by 28 U.S.C. § 1871, should be automatically applied. Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED and CERTIFIED that:

Grand jurors required to attend more than 45 days of actual service shall be paid an additional \$10 fee for each day in excess of 45 days of actual service commencing on the first day of extended service; and

Petit jurors required to attend more than 10 days in hearing one case shall be paid an additional \$10 fee for each day in excess of 10 days of actual service commencing on the first day of extended service.

This Administrative Order shall serve as certification for payment vouchers containing additional juror attendance fees. No further court order or signed certification shall be necessary.
