Pursuant to the Amended Plan of the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee for providing representation to defendants who are financially unable to obtain an adequate defense in criminal cases, a Panel Selection Committee was established to assist in the selection of private attorneys to serve as members of the Criminal Justice Act Panel (CJA Panel) of attorneys for this district.

The Amended Plan sets forth that the Committee shall consist of at least one judicial officer, two members of the private bar who engage in active federal court criminal practice, the Federal Public Defender, and a CJA Panel Attorney Representative. The judicial officer shall serve as chairperson and Federal Public Defender as its permanent secretary. Committee members from the private bar serve three-year terms.

The Court adopts the recommendations of the Committee and appoints C. Anne Tipton, Howard Wagerman, and Edward Stanton III, to replace outgoing Committee members Walter Bailey and Lorna McClusky. C. Anne Tipton, Howard Wagerman, and Edward Stanton III shall each serve a three-year term on the CJA Panel Selection Committee. All terms to commence on February 8, 2020.

The Court expresses appreciation to Walter Bailey and Lorna McClusky for their extended service on the CJA Panel Selection Committee.
