IN RE: THE RANDOM ASSIGNMENT OF
CASES TO MAGISTRATE JUDGES UPON THE
RETIREMENT OF MAGISTRATE JUDGE BROWN

Local Rule 4 of the United States District Court for Western District of Tennessee requires that each case randomly assigned to a district judge also be randomly assigned to a magistrate judge. Inasmuch as Magistrate Judge Aaron Brown, retired upon expiration of his term of office on March 31, 1995 and in anticipation of the timely appointment of a magistrate judge to fill the vacancy created by this retirement, the Clerk of Court is directed to randomly assign cases to the magistrate judges according to the following procedure

The Clerk shall establish a new magistrate assignment code of 51AD. Magistrate Judge J. Daniel Breen will continue to receive one-fourth of the Western Division cases, the remaining cases being equally divided between Magistrate Judge Allen and the magistrate judge position designated as 51AD. However, Magistrate Judges Allen and Breen will receive an equal share of the assignments made to code 51AD until the appointment of Magistrate Judge Brown's replacement. At such time, all matters initially assigned to code 51AD will be transferred by Magistrate Judges Allen and Breen to the new magistrate judge

Until the appointment of the replacement magistrate judge, district judges referring cases to a magistrate judge will specify

either Magistrate Judge Allen or Magistrate Judge Breen in the order of reference.
