Commensurate with this election, Senior District Judge Horton requests that his name be removed from the Clerk's civil and criminal case assignment systems for a four month period beginning May 16 to afford him an opportunity to work on his pending civil and criminal cases. ORDERED, that the Clerk of Court remove Senior District Judge Odell Horton's name from both the civil and criminal case assignment systems for a period of four months beginning May 16, 1995, or until otherwise ordered
