The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 authorized and provided funds to raise the non-capital hourly panel attorney compensation rate from \$129 to \$132, and the maximum hourly capital rate from \$183 to \$185 (for federal capital prosecutions and capital post-conviction proceedings). These rates apply to attorneys appointed to represent eligible persons under the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, and the Antiterrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act of 1996, codified in part in 18 U.S.C. § 3599.

Effective January 1, 2017, the mileage rate for the use of privately owned vehicles while on official business is .535 cents per mile.
