Memphis Courtroom #1, 2, 3, 4 & 7 - AV system.

The District Courtrooms have a state of the art AV system that was installed during the Fall of 2011.

Features include;

11 fixed microphones at strategic points.

4 wireless lapel microphones.

2 wireless handheld microphones.

16x9 LCD monitors at counsel tables, podium, well area and witness stand.

Annotation monitors at podium and witness stand.

15 ft HD format screen for Jury viewing with 5000 lumen LCD projector.

50 inch plasma monitor for gallery viewing.

Witness stand has a dedicated speaker with volume control.

Jury box has 3 dedicated speakers.

Color evidence printer.

Digital document camera

Teleconference and telephonic interpreter system built in.

Infrared interpreter and hearing impaired system

Wireless RF interpreter system available

VGA and HDMI inputs at counsel table, podium and witness stand for laptop connection.

Composite and S video connections at podium for external AV equipment (VCR, DVD, etc. Counsel must provide their own playback equipment)

Video Conference capability in each courtroom. Advance notice required.

AMX control system. Courtroom deputy has complete control over all audio and video.
