The United States Attorney has indicated in its Motion to Lift Stay that the Department of Justice funding has been restored. Therefore, the United States Attorney has requested that the stay ordered by the court be lifted. Based upon this motion and for good cause shown, it is hereby:

**ORDERED**, that the previously imposed stay be lifted and that all current deadlines in civil cases affected by the previous Order shall be extended for a period of time commensurate with the duration of this stay, 35 days.

The Court shall distribute this Administrative Order:

- (a) by electronic service to all registered CM/ECF users;
- (b) by first-class mail to unregistered civil litigants, including pro se litigants, and to attorneys pending pro hac vice admission; and
- (c) by posting the Administrative Order on the Court's public website.
