 - Please be sure that the form is filled out in its entirety, including the "Motion for Admission" section at the bottom of page 2.

- (2) **Certificate of Good Standing** from the Tennessee Supreme Court or other state supreme court.
- (3) **Check for \$200.00** dated October 5, 2010 and made payable to "Supreme Court of the U.S."
