May 2, 2012: Topics to be discussed are: Economic Crimes (with an emphasis on restitution), Categorical Approach, Firearms and/or Immigration and/or Multiple counts.
May 3, 2013: Topics to be discussed are: Sex Offenses/Child Pornography and Chapter Seven Supervised Release Revocations

All information provided will be relevant to Sixth Circuit and Supreme Court case law and promises to be time well spent.

Attorneys will be able to earn CLE credits.

USSC training will be held at Memphis Bioworks located 20 S. Dudley (Corner of Madison and Dudley) in the first floor conference room area which is one floor up from ground level. Continental breakfast will be available and there will be an afternoon treat.
