Pursuant to the rule-making authority granted the court by 28 U.S.C. § 2071, Local Rule 83.1 is hereby amended by replacing paragraph (f) with the following provision on courtroom attire:

(f) Courtroom Attire. All attorneys appearing in this

court shall be appropriately attired, coat and tie for men, comparable attire for women, and shall not be groomed or attired in a manner reasonably calculated to distract attention from the proceedings, call attention to themselves, or as to show disrespect to the court.
