United States District Judge Jon P. McCalla, pursuant to the eligibility afforded him under 28 U.S.C. § 371(b)(1), has elected to retire from active service effective August 23, 2013. Commensurate with this election, Senior District Judge McCalla requests that his name be removed from the criminal case assignment system to afford him an opportunity to focus on his pending civil case load and the responsibilities associated with his designation as a patent judge in the Patent Pilot Project. Therefore, it is

ORDERED, that the Clerk of Court remove Chief Judge Jon McCalla's name from the criminal case assignment system effective Thursday, August 1, 2013.
