IN RE: ORDER ADOPTING MODIFICATION TO THE AMENDED PLAN FOR THE RANDOM SELECTION OF GRAND AND PETIT JURORS)))	Administrative Order 2020-05	

At its meeting of February 8, 2020, this Court adopted a modification to its *Amended Plan for the Random Selection of Grand and Petit Jurors* ("Jury Plan"), effective June 1, 2005, as approved by the Judicial Council of the Sixth Circuit of the United States, to increase the number of names randomly drawn from the master jury wheel in the Eastern Division from two hundred fifty (250) names to three hundred (300) names. The increase having been prompted by a rise in the number of jury trials. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that paragraph two of Section VIII of the Jury Plan (Drawing from Master Jury Wheel) be amended as follows:

As the jury master wheels shall be reconstituted following each general election, the Clerk shall draw, no later than May following a general election, one thousand (1,000) names at random from the master wheel in the Western Division and three hundred (300) two hundred fifty (250) names at random from the master wheel in the Eastern Division.

This modification will be effective immediately upon approval by the Sixth Circuit

Judicial Council and shall remain so until such time as the Judicial Council of the Sixth

Circuit may direct otherwise. Nothing in this modification shall preclude the service of any

juror summoned or empaneled on or before the date upon which the modification shall

become effective. Accordingly, it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court notify the Sixth Circuit Judicial Council, the

Administrative Office of the United States Courts, and the Attorney General of the United States of the modification herein described, consistent with provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 1863(b)(3).
