MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE STANDING
LOCAL RULES COMMITTEE

Administrative Order No. 2025-32

Pursuant to the determination of the District Judges of the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee and in the interests of the Court, the bar, and the public, a thirteen member Standing Local Rules Committee ("Committee"), along with an *ex officio* judicial officer member, was established and appointed by Administrative Order No. 2012-04 on February 15, 2012.

At Article V (Governance and Membership), Section 4 (Officers and Terms of Membership) of the By-Laws of the Committee, it is established that, following the expiration of a member's term, the Committee may re-nominate that member to serve another term or nominate and submit to the Court a new nominee for the Court's consideration. Section 5 of Article V sets out that each member may serve for a maximum of six (6) consecutive years.

Upon the expiration of the terms of Courtney Leyes (civil practitioner) and Jessica Farris Salonus (civil practitioner), the following names were recommended for the Court's consideration to fill the vacancies created:

Audrey Calkins (civil practitioner)
Sara Barnett (civil practitioner)

In addition, the Committee recommended to the Court that current Committee members David M. Bell and J. Russ Bryant be reappointed to serve a second three (3) year term.

Based on a unanimous vote, the Court hereby adopts the recommendations and appoints Audrey Caulkins and Sara Barnett to serve their first three (3) year terms, and reappoints

David M. Bell and J. Russ Bryant to serve their second three (3) year terms on the Standing Local Rules Committee, commencing on the date of the entry of this Order.
