MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE STANDING
LOCAL RULES COMMITTEE****Administrative Order No. 2026-13**

Pursuant to the determination of the District Judges of the United States District Court for the Western District of Tennessee, and in the interests of the Court, the bar, and the public, a thirteen-member Standing Local Rules Committee (“Committee”), along with an *ex officio* judicial officer member, was established and appointed by Administrative Order No. 2012-04 on February 15, 2012.

Article V (Governance and Membership), Section 4 (Officers and Terms of Membership) of the By-Laws of the Committee establishes that, upon the expiration of a member’s term, the Committee may re-nominate that member to serve an additional term or nominate and submit to the Court a new nominee for consideration. Section 5 of Article V further provides that each member may serve for a maximum of six (6) consecutive years.

Upon the expiration of the terms of Jonathan E. Nelson (civil practitioner) and Jennifer D. Free (criminal practitioner), the following individuals were recommended for the Court’s consideration to fill the resulting vacancies:

Matthew M. Lubozynski (civil practitioner)

Alexander D. Camp (criminal practitioner)

In addition, the Committee recommended that current members Kaitlyn A. Hansen (civil practitioner) and Janika N. White (criminal practitioner) be reappointed to serve a second three-year term.

The Committee further recommended that the following members serve in leadership roles: David M. Bell, Gregory A. Wagner, and Kaitlyn A. Hansen. Specifically, the Committee recommended David M. Bell to serve as Chairperson; Gregory A. Wagner to serve as Criminal Subcommittee Chair; and Kaitlyn A. Hansen to continue serving as Reporter.

Based on a unanimous vote, the Court hereby adopts the recommendations and appoints Matthew M. Lubozynski and Alexander D. Camp to serve their first three-year terms, and reappoints Kaitlyn A. Hansen and Janika N. White to serve their second three-year terms on the Committee. Additionally, the Court appoints the following members to leadership roles: David M. Bell, Chairperson; Gregory A. Wagner, Criminal Subcommittee Chair; and Kaitlyn A. Hansen, Reporter. The terms and leadership roles commenced on March 23, 2026.
