Administrative Order No. 2024-05

Mays for all proceeding until further order of the Court.

All *pro se* prisoner cases filed under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 in the Western Division of the Western District of Tennessee will be automatically assigned to the Honorable Samuel H. Mays for all proceedings. After the designated number of cases in the Eastern Division have been assigned to the Honorable J. Daniel Breen, all future *pro se* prisoner cases filed under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 in the Eastern Division will be assigned to the Honorable Samuel H. Mays for all proceedings until further order of the Court.
