IN RE: ORDER ESTABLISHING TERM OF SERVICE FOR THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF TENNESSEE

Admin. Order No. 2025-06

By Administrative Order No. 2021-15, the judges of the Court established a term of service of no more than four years for the Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Tennessee. Thereafter, the judges discussed the term and decided, by unanimous vote, to extend that term to no more than five years, to establish a reasonable time of service. Upon the expiration of a Chief Judge's term, the position will typically rotate to the next most senior sitting bankruptcy judge of the Court.

Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Administrative Order No. 2021-15 is no longer in effect and the term of service for the Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Tennessee shall be no more than five years.
