IN RE: APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL FOR PURPOSES OF LIMITED REPRESENTATION AT INITIAL APPEARANCES

Administrative Order No. 2025-14

The Court hereby appoints the Federal Public Defender's Office, or, if necessary, an attorney from the Criminal Justice Act Panel, to provide limited representation to each defendant, with their consent, prior to and during their initial appearance before the duty United States Magistrate Judge. The purpose of this limited representation is to inform the defendants of (1) the nature of the charges, (2) the initial appearance process, and (3) their rights under the Bail Reform Act. This limited representation appointment shall be effective as of the defendants' first consultation with counsel before their initial appearance. At the initial appearance, the duty United States Magistrate Judge will address representation and may convert the limited-representation appointment to a full appointment, should the defendant so request, upon a showing of the defendant's indigency and qualification for appointed counsel.
